CASH/IPADS FOR GUNS
■ FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Do I need identification to surrender a gun?
✓ Yes, a valid ID is required.
- How do I bring a gun to the drop off site?
✓ Gun must be placed in a plastic or paper bag or box.
- Can I transport the gun in a car?
✓ If transporting the gun by car, the gun must be transported in the trunk of the car.
- When do I get the pre-paid card?
✓ After the gun is inspected by a department specialist.
- How many guns can I surrender?
✓ You may surrender as many guns as you wish, but you will only receive payment for up to three guns for a maximum payment of \$600.
- Is there a phone number I can call for more information?
✓ Yes, you can call 846-610-5223 for more information on the NYC Gun Buy Back Program to reduce violent crime.
- Can any member of the public surrender a gun?
✓ Yes, (active or retired law enforcement officers & licensed gun dealers are not eligible to participate in the program.)
- Can I have someone surrender the gun on my behalf?
✓ Yes, someone else can surrender the gun on your behalf.

Rhythms of the Land is a valentine to generations of Black farmers in the United States from the enslavement period to the present, whose intense love of the land and dedication to community enabled them to survive against overwhelming odds.

A large number of African American sharecroppers and tenant farmers migrated to the North after World Wars I and II for factory jobs. These are the stories of the people that remained on or returned to the land and continued the agrarian traditions passed down from their ancestors.

The film spotlights an array of farmers, rice growers, hog and dairy ranchers, sharecroppers, basket-weavers, shrimp farmers, vegetable farmers, and gardeners, each sharing their memorable stories for the first time.
