Programs offered in partnership with Junior Achievement of NY:

-*High School Heroes* program provides service-learning and leadership development opportunities to high school students in their communities.

-*<u>Finance Park</u> is a month-long program that introduces students to personal financial planning and career exploration. At the culmination of this teacher-led program, students visit JA Finance Park, a realistic on-site or virtual community, to put into practice what they've learned by developing and committing to a personal budget.*

-Job Shadow: Students learn how to research career opportunities and the skills needed to land and keep their dream job
