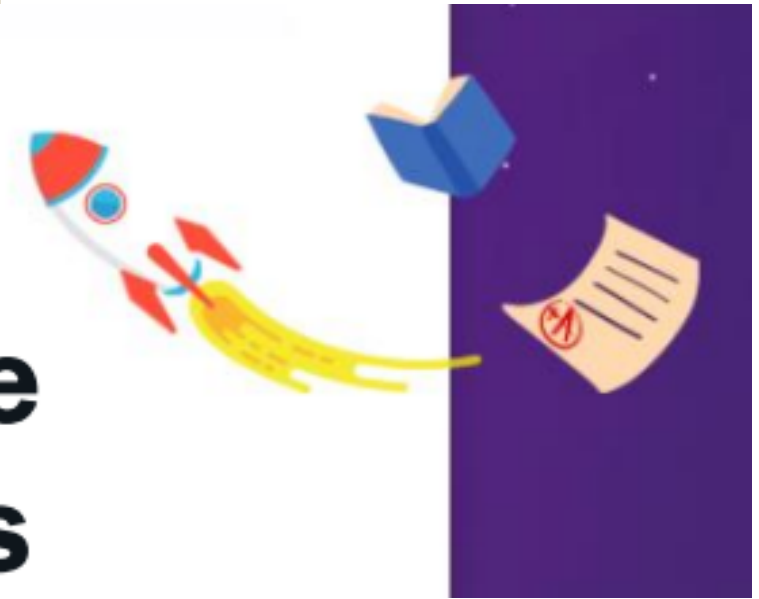


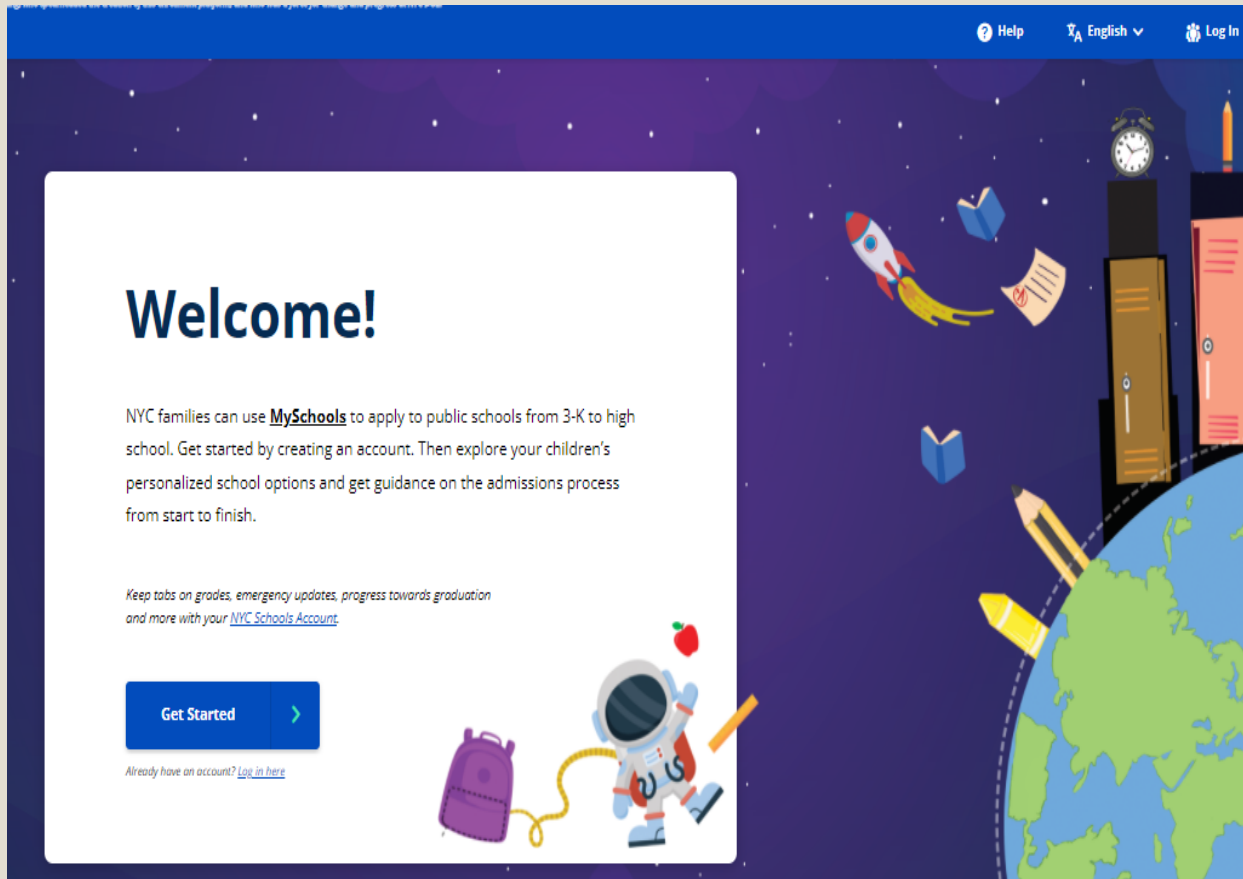

Creating a MySchools Account



Let's get started by setting up your MySchools account. It won't take long.

Create your account:

This will be your login (or username)

Must be at least 8 characters.

You will need:

1. A personal email address (parent email not necessarily NYC Account email)
2. You will get a confirmation email and be able to start filling in your data



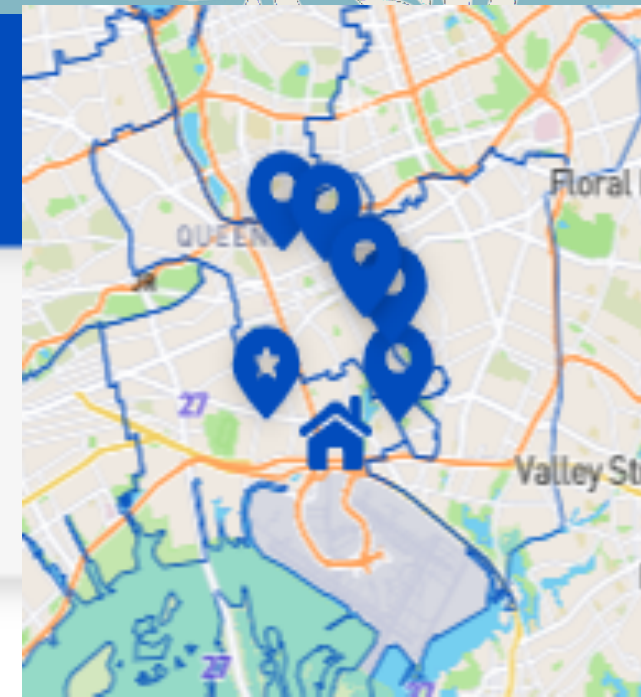

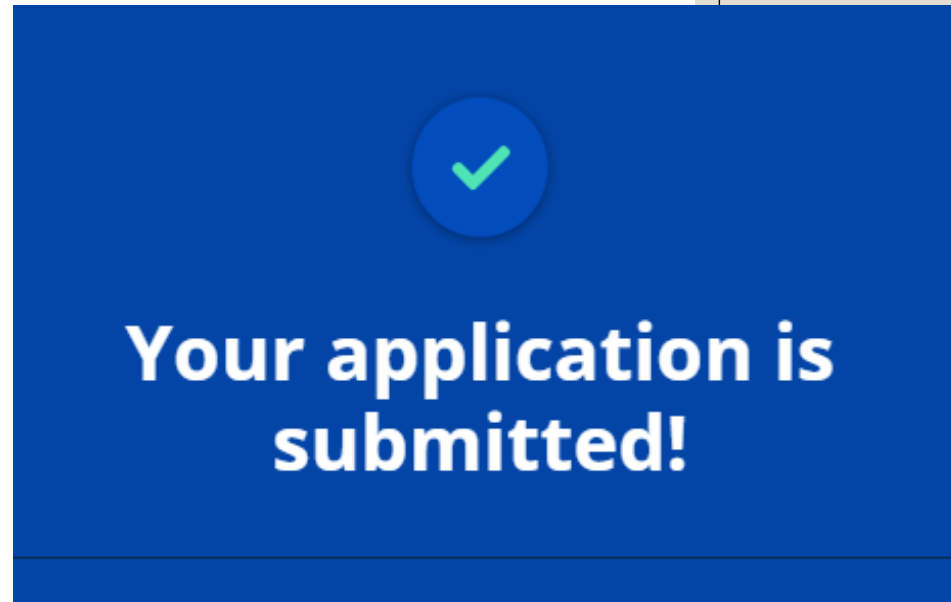
