



To create a pathway for NYC students from diverse backgrounds, preparing them for fulfilling and well-paying careers in the film and television sectors.






MISSION OF SCHOOL

The Motion Picture Tech is a CTE public high school committed to creating an inclusive pathway to careers in the Film & Television Industries.


We prepare young diverse students to become film & media industry professionals, teaching you the creative and technical skills to take on below-the-line production roles in film and television.

The Opportunity

These aren't just jobs – they're **good jobs**. And there are plenty of them.

- 95% of industry jobs are technical, behind-the-camera roles - BIPOC workers only make up 5% of the current pool.
- 65,000 below-the-line production job opportunities exist in the industry.
- Salaries in the entertainment industry are **47%** higher than the national average.
- Across the country, \$84 billion in wages were earned by entertainment industry workers in 2022.

SITING AND ADMISSIONS

- New building Q472 is opening at 53-16 Northern Boulevard in District 30 for the 2025-2026 school year, subject to PEP approval. NYCPS is working to identify temporary space in Northern Queens to open and incubate the ninth grade for the 2024-2025 school year.
- This building is expected to house 3 Pathways High Schools, each with about 800-900 students at-scale. Motion Picture Tech will be one of these schools.

• Motion Picture Tech is in the High School Directory for Fall 2024 Enrollment, giving priority to Queens students. It is unscreened.

HOW TO APPLY

High School Admissions Important Dates!

- Tuesday, October 3, 2023: High School Application Opens
- Friday, December 1, 2023: High School Application Closes
- Thursday, March 7, 2024: High School Offer Release

Students can apply up to 12 options with their high school application. Important to list the schools in order of TRUE priority. Students can submit their application online (MySchools) or through a school counselor. Some programs have additional requirements, such as an audition or assessment, and some programs make offers based on applicants' academic records. MPT IS UNSCREENED!


