- Reduced fare Omnicards offered for low income families (Fair Fares NYC) - <https://access.nyc.gov/programs/fair-fares/#how-it-works>
- NYC Kids Rise Save for College Program - <https://nykidsrise.org/save-for-college-program/> In school year 2025-2026, every kindergarten, first grade, second grade, third grade, and fourth grade student enrolled in NYC public schools (including participating charter schools) is eligible to participate, no matter their family income or immigration status. If your child is eligible, they will be automatically enrolled in the Save for College Program and receive a free NYC Scholarship Account unless you choose not to participate and opt out. As long as you take no action during the Opt-out Process, your child will be automatically enrolled
- **Jury found social media platforms addictive** - California jury found Meta and YouTube liable for designing addictive features that caused mental health

issues in a young user, labeling them negligent for focusing on profits over child safety (infinite scrolling, recommendations, etc.)
