





QCC PATHWAY AT BTECH...

- ★ Students attending QCC throughout High School earn **on average 30-35 dual-enrolled college credits.**
- ★ **Two Degree track options** at QCC:
 - Applied Science Degree, **Internet & Information Technology**
 - Associate Degree, **Business Administration**
- ★ **QCC articulation with Baruch College Zicklin School of Business** (*Business Administration Degree*)
 - ****BTECH is the **Only** NYCDOE High School with a pathway from a community college to Baruch Zicklin School of Business*
- ★ **Two College Liaisons** assigned specifically to BTECH students.
- ★ Students must meet eligibility requirements to attend
- ★ Soft Skill Workshops, QCC tours and visits, Orientations, Info and Q&A Sessions tailored for BTECH students.



AP PATHWAY AT BTECH...

- Students take an Advanced Placement Courses in 10th, 11th and 12th grade
- Expectation of earning Advanced Regents Diploma
- AP Courses: Biology, Environmental Science, Music, Seminar, U.S. History, and World History (2024-2025 Academic Year)
- Students are expected to take AP Exams in at LEAST (3) AP courses throughout their High School career and earn a '4' or higher.
- Students take more liberal arts and humanities electives

BTECH IS A New York State Approved CTE SCHOOL!

Career and technical education (**CTE**) in Information Technology represents an additional opportunity for **high school** students to earn a certification in AWS Cloud Fundamentals
