Fellows will:

- **Learn restorative justice, circle facilitation, conflict resolution, and given opportunities to practice.**
- **Engage in networking and advocacy opportunities to support their Credible Messenger journey.**
- **Receive a \$2,000 stipend for their participation and completion of this fellowship.**

Eligibility:

- **Ages 18–24**
- **Currently serve in a community-based violence prevention role**
- **System-impacted and committed to ending cycles of violence**
- **Committed to supporting and strengthening underserved communities**
